The program will be in Creative Space training center and group accommodation in Hollókő.

Holloko is a small village located in North-Hungary, by 100 km from Budapest. It is part of the UNESCO World Heritage.

In Creative Space you will be accommodated in 4 bedded rooms which all have its own showers and toilets. In the building of the group accommodation you can find the training room, dining area, common social areas.
