Location



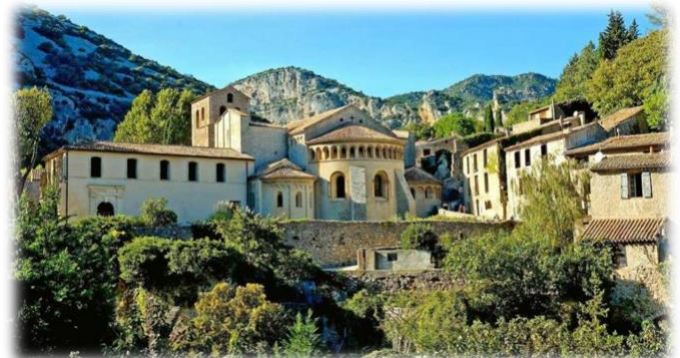
Location : Clermont-l'Hérault is a small town of 8.500 inhabitants located in the region Languedoc-Roussillon-Midi-Pyrénées, in the south of France. As a Mediterranean region, it has a dry and hot climate (mild in winter) with a shrub land vegetation. The town lies 40 km north-west from Montpellier, the second biggest city in the region, with a train station and an airport. We can go there by the bus set up by the region: <http://www.herault-transport.fr>.

Around Clermont-l'Hérault: Montpellier is a sunny city and is the second biggest student city in France. It's a dynamic city that offers a lot of activities and events with a particularly pleasant historic centre. The region boasts great historical heritage like the Guilhem's castle in Clermont-l'Hérault and offers a lot of different activities: hiking, river and beach sports etc. This is an area rich in vineyards and located on the edge of the Camargue park to the east, with large salt marshes, and south of the Cevennes National Park.

Accommodation : You will live together in a shared flat in Clermont-l'Hérault, close to the delegation and accessible by foot. You'll have your own room but you'll share the common rooms with other volunteers, EVS or Civic Service. The flat contains all conveniences: bathroom, toilets, kitchen, washing machine, WIFI, etc. You will cook and clean yourself, taking into account everyone's diets. The town has all the useful shops you could need: supermarket, bakery, snacks, bar, restaurants, tobacco shop, etc.

Travel and accommodation:

The costs for your accommodation, food and travel to the workplace are covered – however, we recommend you bring some pocket money: there are ATM and bureau de change in every airport and in Montpellier. **You'll get 115€ as pocket money per month.** During your first days here, your tutor will help you to create a French Bank account, to get a French phone etc... Insurance: you will be insured via CIGNA European Benefits – for further details please ask your sending organization! Bring all the documents the sending organisation gives you. You will get an Orientation on Arrival during which we will explain the insurance and your coverage by the EVS program. Two trainings are also planned by our NA, in order to give you an opportunity to share and discuss about your will and wishes at your arrival and to compare with your experience at mid-term.
